As the authors of these essays remind us, tourists visited Yosemite long before its establishment as a national park; and the issues of park development so hotly debated today were raised and debated first in Yosemite, nearly a hundred years ago. This book is a practical manual for bonsai enthusiasts, whether beginners or those with experience of bonsai care. It covers all topics relating to bonsai, from its history through to the skills needed for the creation of individual bonsai styles. Information is given on how trees grow in nature together with detailed step-by-step instructions on all the techniques needed to care for a bonsai tree: watering, feeding and display; pruning for maintenance and reshaping; wiring to shape; re-potting; rocks, groups and landscapes; pests, diseases and hygiene. Forests are considered the lungs of the planet, as they consume and store carbon dioxide and produce oxygen. These biomes, defined as ecological communities dominated by long-lived woody vegetation, historically have provided an economic foundation for growing nations, supplying wood for buildings, firewood for fuel, and land for expanding cities and farms. For centuries, industrial nations in Europe and the United States have relied on large tracts of forestland for economic prosperity. The research presented in this book reveals that population pressures are causing considerable environmental distress in even the most remote forest areas. Three detailed case studies are presented. The first provides an assessment of illegal logging deep in South America's Amazon rain forest, a region closely tied to food and product demands thousands of miles away. The second examines the effect of increased hunting in Central Africa's Congo forest, which threatens wildlife, especially mammal species with slower reproductive cycles. Finally the third describes encroachment on old-growth tropical forests on the Southern Pacific island of Borneo, which today is better managed thanks to the collective planning and conservation efforts of the governments of Brunei, Indonesia, and Malaysia. When twenty-three-year-old George Meléndez Wright arrived in Yosemite National Park in 1927 to work as a ranger naturalist—the first Hispanic person to occupy any professional position in the National Park Service (NPS)—he had already visited every national park in the western United States, including McKinley (now Denali) in Alaska. Two years later, he would organize the first science-based wildlife survey of the western parks, forever changing how the NPS would manage wildlife and natural resources. At a time when national parks routinely fed bears garbage as part of “shows” and killed “bad” predators like wolves, mountain lions, and coyotes, Wright's new ideas for

conservation set the stage for the modern scientific management of parks and other public lands. Tragically, Wright died in a 1936 car accident while working to establish parks and wildlife refuges on the US-Mexico border. To this day, he remains a celebrated figure among conservationists, wildlife experts, and park managers. In this book, Jerry Emory, a conservationist and writer connected to Wright's family, draws on hundreds of letters, field notes, archival research, interviews, and more to offer both a biography of Wright and a historical account of a crucial period in the evolution of US parks and the wilderness movement. With a foreword by former NPS director Jonathan B. Jarvis, *George Meléndez Wright* is a celebration of Wright's unique upbringing, dynamism, and enduring vision that places him at last in the pantheon of the great American conservationists. Today the genus has shrunk to one species with approximately 5,000 mature individuals in southeastern China's Xiaohu Valley. The majestic coast redwood (*Sequoia sempervirens*) is a California endemic tree of economic, ecological, and cultural value. Coast redwoods are also noteworthy due to their genomic composition; they are polyploid, having six copies of each chromosome rather than the two copies seen in almost all other conifers. It is known that polyploidy in *Sequoia* arose at least 34 millions years ago (Ma) because fossils from this era have stomatal guard-cells (known proxies for ploidy) whose size indicates polyploidy. Diverse mechanisms have been proposed to explain the origin of polyploidy in the coast redwood, and some authors have argued hybridization among multiple redwood lineages played a role. We sequenced leaf-expressed genes (a transcriptome) from all three redwood species and a close relative and used statistical analysis to show that polyploidy in coast redwood is unlikely to have involved hybridization. To further test this finding, we then sequenced a targeted subset of the genome for 8 redwood accessions and two outgroups. These data support the same conclusion: polyploidy did not involve hybridization among divergent species. We also used the sequences, combined with the fossil record, to infer the divergence dates of *Sequoia* from its sister group, giant sequoia (*Sequoiadendron giganteum*), and to determine when the different chromosomal copies of *Sequoia* genes last shared common ancestry. We found that the *Sequoia* and *Sequoiadendron* lineages diverged ~ 51 Ma, whereas most *Sequoia* gene copies diverged from one another ~13Ma. The latter date is noticeably much more recent than the polyploidy event itself (>34 Ma). We argued that this finding can be explained by inferring that the three pairs of genes (homeologs) in *Sequoia* exchanged genetic information long after polyploidization. This inference is consistent with observations that, even today, *Sequoia* chromosomes do not consistently pair up during cell division. Our elucidation of the complex genetics and genome history of the coast redwood provides important background information for efforts to ensure the long-term survival of this magnificent and iconic tree species in the face of rapid changes in the California climate.
